Pool and Patio Rules

- 1. The pool may be used only between the hours of 9 AM until dusk.

 No night swimming!**
 - Do not swallow pool water!**
- 2. Residents and overnight guests use the pool at their own risk. Visitors (other than overnight guests) are not permitted to use the pool unless in the presence of the unit owner.
- 3. **Bordeaux Club Regulations require that a shower be taken before entering the pool.**** Suntan lotions and creams must be removed because grease clogs the filter and scum collects on the sides of the pool. The shower is located in the Chickee and is for men and women. It should not be used for shampooing hair. Use your own apartment shower for this purpose.
- 4. Children under 13 years of age must be accompanied by an adult and are not permitted to play in the patio area. Swim diapers must be worn by any child not toilet trained and any person with continence issues. If a child or adult has an accident, the owner of the unit in which the person resides, will be responsible for the cost of cleanup of the pool.
- 5. Bobby pins and hair pins must be removed. These items cause damage to the filtration system.
- 6. Use of objects, interfering with bathers or sunbathers are not permitted in the pool or patio area. (Play equipment, balls, toys, air mattresses, etc.)
- 7. **Plastic or metal containers only** are permitted in the pool/patio area. **No Glass!** ** No food should be served other than at the Chickee or designated patio area. No gum is allowed at the pool areas. Please use the appropriate receptacles to dispose of trash, ash tray contents, etc.
- 8. Chaise lounges are provided in the pool area. They must be covered with a towel or equivalent when sunbathing. The chaise lounges are available on a first come basis and cannot be "reserved" by any means (such as towel draping or moving). Pool lounger backs must be lowered when finished using. Pool umbrellas must be folded and tied when finished using.
- 9. All persons must be properly attired when going to and from the pool or beach. Ladies must be covered with a robe or other acceptable beach attire. Gentlemen must wear tops and a swimsuit or shorts. Beach shoes must be worn. Bathers should dry themselves and wipe the sand and dirt off their shoes before entering the courtyard and/or building. Please do not use the center entrance when coming from the beach. Hoses for removing excess sand are on the west end of the north and south buildings.
- 10. Doors to toilets and shower should be kept closed.
- 11. Pool equipment, life line, hook strainers, etc., should be used in emergency situations only or by the Bordeaux Manager.
- 12. No stereos or radios are to be used in the pool area unless they are used with earphones. Please use courtesy with cell phones. If you have a call, please leave the area where others are relaxing.
- 13. Pool bathing capacity: 20 persons max. **
- 14. Please dispose of trash in the receptacles provided.**
